<u>Financial Review</u> – Lynda Potas reviewed the current financial statements. As of activity through 05/14/14 the Operating account had a balance of \$6,562.43 and the Reserve account had a balance of \$14,387.52. Through 05/14/14 we are at \$11,880.23 or 50% of the annual income and \$7,345.07 or 30.91% of the annual expense. Nick Falco motioned to approve the financial report, seconded by Patrick O'Brien. All were in favor.

<u>Legal/Home Sales Update</u> – Lynda Potas reviewed the reports.

Landscape/Wetland Update:

<u>Pichardo Landscaping</u> – A four year bid was submitted to the Board for review noting no increase for two years and an increase from \$600 to \$671 in 2016 and to \$707 in 2017. Matt Bold motioned to approve, seconded by Patrick O'Brien. All were in favor.

<u>Mulch</u> – CMS stated we were due for mulch and had a budget of \$2,081. Pichardo Landscaping would be contacted for pricing and application.

<u>Aquatic Weed Control</u> – CMS reported that treatments began on 4/29/14 and the Huntley pond and Center ponds would be reviewed every other week with a door hanger delivered for each visit to CMS.

<u>McGinty</u>– The burn of the Huntley wetland areas and over seeding of same was completed in April.

<u>Homeowners Open Forum</u> – No homeowners present.
